Champagne Jean-Noël Haton, Damery - Champagne

Since 1610 when Nicolas Haton started as a grape grower, the Haton family has had a long and rich history in Champagne. It was years later that Octave Haton founded the champagne house in 1928. This independent family-owned Maison de Champagne is located in the Marne Valley, in the village of Damery, close to Epernay, a key area in Champagne. The family currently owns 25 hectares of vineyard; manages an additional 15 hectares from viticulture to vinification and source grapes from 60 more hectares all over Champagne including Grands Crus and Premiers Crus. Viticulture philosophy is sustainable. Today, Champagne Jean-Noël Haton is part of the top 10 most important winegrowing families that still manages its own champagne house and remains 100% family-owned. The family is dedicated to continue their heritage and to bring great bubbles to all our tables!



Champagne Collet, Aÿ - Champagne

FRANCE | Bordeaux



Château de Grissac, Côtes de Bourg - Bordeaux

Château de Grissac is located in Côtes de Bourg, on the right bank of the Gironde estuary. The estate with an historical 17th century manor with 31 hectares of beautiful vineyards, planted essentially of merlot and cabernet sauvgnon. Over time, the manor was transformed into a fortified castle. The edifice is currently undergoing renovation to become a luxury boutique resort offering oenotourism experiences in the heart of the vineyard. Opening summer 2025. This unique estate encapsulates Bordeaux's rich history, natural beauty and wine culture. A real gem to discover as it becomes an exceptional wine destination. Under the supervision of acclaimed consultant Stéphane Derenoncourt, their wines are showing balance, elegance and fruitiness.



Château Grimont, Cadillac - Côtes de Bordeaux

It was in 1958 that the Yung family fell under the charm of this remarkable estate on the banks of the Garonne River in Quinsac, southeast Bordeaux. Built during the 17th and 18th century, this majestic château belonged for many years to writer, Eugène Sue, who sought solace and inspiration at Grimont. A family affair estate with two brothers, Paul and Jean who were joined in recent years by Arthur, Jean's son, who in turn brought fresh energy and new directions with HVE3 certification and other viticulture advancements. Château Grimont is sought after as a Cru of exceptional finesse, and was awarded the Gold Medal by the Minister for the best kept vineyard in Bordeaux. In this clay-gravel vineyard, mainly planted on slopes, the family continues its quest to maintain tradition and quality and to bring out the best of this exceptional site!

FRANCE | Bordeaux (continued)



Château La Pierrière, Castillon - Côtes de Bordeaux

In the late 1800s, Château La Pierrière was a benchmark in Saint-Émilion! When the area of the appellation was defined in 1934, there was no question of including this 13th century fortified castle, located at the opposite end of the spectrum from Château Cheval Blanc and outside the municipal boundaries. It met all the standards of the purest Saint-Emilion. It owes its name to the rocky outcrop. Its turrets look over and which, from Pomerol to this easternmost point, forms the exceptional subsoil of this famous region. The appellation system thus deprived Château La Pierrière of an advantage that its terroir has nevertheless preserved. The 40-hectare estate is planted of 80% merlot, 15% cabernet franc and 5% cabernet sauvignon with an average age of the vine of 35 years.



Château Loudenne, Médoc - Bordeaux

Château Loudenne is a historic property with over 350 years of history. The geographic location of the winery is at the heart of the Médoc, on the banks of the Gironde estuary. The situation of the estate on the riverbanks provides an exceptional terroir for wine growing that is rich in gravel. The estuary also as a positive impact on the climate of the region. With all of these elements in place, Château Loudenne continues to produce distinctive and elegant wines made from their estate vineyards that surround this historic "Suffolk pink" château. Since its acquisition by the Gouache family, the château has entered into a new chapter towards establishing a level of quality and dedication to its terroir.

Domaine Philippe Girard, Savigny-les-Beaune

Located in the heart of the village of Savigny-les-Beaune in Burgundy, Domaine Philippe Girard has been in the family since 1529. Today, Arnaud Girard works along-side with his father, Philippe. The Domaine encompasses 22 hectares of premium vineyards, over 14 communes going from the Côte Chalonnaise to Côte de Nuits. Their philosophy is about the importance of working the vineyards with respect of the terroirs and traditions. Domaine Philippe Girard crafts wines of incredible finesse, elegance & complexity.



La Chablisienne, Chablis - Burgundy

La Chablisienne was established in 1923 to withhold economic challenges after World War I and help the widows of Chablis to vinify and commercialize their wines. Today, La Chablisienne is owned by 250 growers families and has grown to own 1,200 hectares of vineyards in Petit Chablis, Chablis and Premier & Grand Cru appellations and produce about 50 cuvées with individual personalities from some of the top vineyards. The state-of-the-art winery is equipped with stainless steel, thermosregulated stainless tanks to ensure freshness and enhance the aromatics that makes Chablis wines unique. Some selected cuvées, as well as Premiers crus and Grands crus, are aged in either 228 liters or 400 liters oak barrels.

FRANCE | Rhône Vallev



Les Vignerons Ardéchois, Ardéche - Rhône

On the right bank of the Rhône river, Vignerons Ardéchois has embodied the excellence of winemaking. Due to a combination of warm climate because of the proximity of the Mediterranean sea and cool due to the altitude and airy thanks to the Mistral, this land is particularly favorable for sustainable viticulture. The quality and diversity of their vineyards allow them to produce wine of character with volume and consistency. An incredible terroir of quality at an affordable price!

FRANCE | Spirits



AR.Spirits, Cognac - Spirits Valley

AR.Spirits is located in Spirits Valley, in the town of Cognac. They produce premium organic spirits (which hold USDA certification) and are committed to sustainability and ethical production. The distillery sources local ingredients such as organic wheat, barley, and botanicals. AR.Spirits' products include organic Gin made from French botanicals, Single Malt Whisky aged in organic Cognac barrels from Bordeaux, and their vegan, gluten-free, quinoa-based Vodka. They actively contribute to "Reforest'Action." by donating a portion of its revenue to fund tree planting and combat deforestation. Through their commitment to produce unique, high-quality organic spirits, AR.Spirits has positioned itself as a visionary leader in the sustainable spirits market, both locally and internationally.

ITALY | Piedmont



Borgogno, Barolo/Langhe - Piedmont

Founded in 1761 by Bartolomeo Borgogno, Borgogno is the most historical winery in Barolo. Located in its heart, the underground cellars continue to represent a rare historical memory of the Langa and the wines are made according to tradition: long spontaneous fermentations in concrete tanks without the use of selected yeasts, and long periods of ageing, strictly in large Slavonian oak barrels. Borgogno owns some of the most prestigious vineyards in the Barolo area (Cannubi, Liste, Fossati, San Pietro delle Viole). With absolute respect for the earth, they use no chemical fertilizers, no herbicides, practice only eco-friendly treatments and enhance biodiversity. This results in being certified as organic for the 2019 harvest. Today, Borgogno continues to be the expression of its terroir, tradition and history, always with a watchful eye on the future.

Cathiard Vineyard, Napa Valley

On the slopes of the Mayacamas mountains, Florence and Daniel Cathiard purchased the estate after falling in love with its biodiversity.
